HOW DO COWS RESPOND TO HEAT STRESS?

- Seek shade and cool areas
- Reduce activityIncrease water intake (if available)
- Reduce feed intake (> 22.5 °C)
 Increase body temperature (39 °C)
- Increase respiration rates (> 70/ml)
 Hormonal changes
- Decrease immune function
- Decrease in rumen fermentation efficiency

MILK PRODUCTION?

Can drop 10% - 25% or more due to:

- More energy used on maintenanceLess energy for productive functions
- Less energy for productive functions
 Lower dru matter intake
- Alterations in nutrient use



WHAT ABOUT REPRODUCTION?

- Decreased:Oestrus intensity and length
 - Fertilitu rate
- Ovarian follicle growth
- Increased early embryonic death
